OFFICERS REPORTS –

Presidents Report GIB Board Meeting 3-23-17

County Water Main Replacement Project from US41 to the Four Way Stop along the Entrance Boulevard: We have completed the easement with Collier County for the disputed strip of land between Westgate and Abbey on the Lake so that the county will not hve to install a portion of the new water main under the north side of IGCB in that area. However, they have still not vetted a contractor and at last account the staff may not go the Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) for approval of the contract until the last BOCC Board meeting in April. This will delay the Neighborhood Information meeting on the project until May and the start of the project until possibly June.

Cable TV Replacement Contract Negotiations: We continue to meet with the bidders on our cable TV replacement contract. All four bidders have bundled both Cable TV, internet access, and other services in their proposals. There is still much work to do to fully understand the proposals and to finalize the negotiations. Most of the bidders are offering fiber optic cable to the house and a free year of phone service.

Loriapi at Park Place West: You might have noticed that the Loriapi have been approved and planted at PPW.
